## Principal's Report:

- 1. **Reopening of school:** The return of second and third grade was delayed a week due to a covid case on campus. Due to safe protocols in place, it remains an isolated incident and the school was able to contact families affected.
- 2. **Returning to campus:** 40 students (used to be on DL) agreed to come back to school ... down from 27%, now 17%.

- 4. *Furloughs:* just announced yesterday. Video sent out today by the DOE: 6 furlough days Jan 1-June 30, one day a month. More information will be released soon.
