Haku Lei Stand, Silent Auction, and Produce/Plant Booth
- 8:00am **All students report to class.** Parents and visitors continue to purchase Haku Lei and visit Silent Auction in cafeteria and Produce and Plant Shop next to the multipurpose room aka old library. Bento booth will open and pass out tickets for those who pre-ordered.
- 9:00am **All booths close** temporarily as everyone assembles for the most special part of our May Fair: our children's performances of song and dance.

Following the May Fair performances, students will return to their classrooms and will enjoy the rest of the event under the supervision of the teacher unless signed out by a parent or guardian. - 12:00pm **Let the games begin!** Game booths open, along with Keiki Korner where the children can redeem scrips for toys, knickknacks, or redeem stamps from the games for prizes. Silent Auction will continue receiving bids on many fantastic items.
- 12:30pm The **Annual Variety Show** will begin on the outdoor stage!
- 12:45pm **Silent Auction closes.**
- 1:15pm **Silent Auction payment** line opens in the cafeteria
- 2:00pm **May Fair Activities come to an end.*****All students who have not been signed out by a parent/guardian return to their classroom.
