1. <u>Audit Committee</u> – performed an audit on the last three years.

- a. Audit Report shared by Catherine Pfeffer (2021 2022); per bylaws needed to complete a report in order for the PTA to begin the new fiscal year. Completed Audit Report in four (4) hours. The new treasurer can now begin signing checks.
- b. The 2019 2021 audits will be done next.
- 2. **Bylaws** needs a Chair and needs to be completed every 2-3 years.
- 3. **Membership** every family will be a member; PTA will cover the Hawai'i State PTSA fees.
 - a. Asking parents to complete the online form to join the PTA.
 - b. Pre-COVID -- the PTA was running strong; during COVID it was difficult for the PTA to meet and fundraise.

NEW BUSINESS

- 1. <u>Craft Fair</u> Leanne Kojima has been working on the craft fair and doing most of the initial work.
 - a. Contacted vendors, food trucks, community booths.
 - b. Need people to sit on the craft fair committee; asking for volunteers.
 - c. Craft fair has usually been one of our three largest fundraisers; this year is a reboot.
 - d. Vendor application/packet on the Noelani PTA website; \$110 booth fee (early bird); booth fee will go up after August 31. Asking for parents to spread the word to potential vendors to participate as in the craft fair.
 - e. There are currently 25 vendors paid and confirmed; 5 booths verbally committed. In the past it was about 125 booths sold.

2. Fall Events

- a. Noelani Day of Service August 19, 2022, 8:00-11:00am
 - i. Students and parents welcome to attend.
 - ii. 24 families signed up so far to help clean the school, paint, and plant.
 - iii. Boys Scouts: 10 adults and 11 scouts signed up.
- b. Trunk-or-Treat
 - i. Need a chair for the event
 - ii. Parents decorate their vehicles and park in the Noelani parking lot where students can go trick-or-treating. Need interested parents to decorate. Also need donations of candy.
 - iii. Possibly coordinate sell of bentos/food for fundraiser for 4th or 5th grade classes.

3. **Budget**

- a. Rough estimates of budget as two of our largest fundraisers are starting up again since COVID began.
- b. President Stanford Togashi shared the estimates for this year's budget.
- c. Possible three biggest fundraisers are Craft Fair, Jogathan and May Fair.

4. Chair positions

- a. Provided a page to attendees with all the chair positions and volunteer opportunities.
- 5. Boy Scouts/Cub Scouts Information shared by Bonnie Tung
 - a. Noelani Cub Scout Pack 35
 - b. Holds an annual family camp at Bellows Beach
 - c. Scouts coordinate hiking, reef walks, beach clean-up, park clean ups, helps PTA with day of service, assists with Noelani craft fair and other events.
 - d. They encourage students to participate in cub scouts.
 - e. Meets once a month and organizes one event a month.
 - f. Council Cost: \$175 per scout; scouts will have to purchase a uniform which is about \$100. Dens meet within their grade level.
